

Making Mentor Observations Work

(2/7/23 - Lead Mentor Training Meeting)

- 1. Who in your building might be able to help watch a class so a Mentor can observe his/her Provisional Teacher?
 - a. Are there days when a Walk to Read Aid or group of Aids don't have Walk to Read or Walk to Math, but are still on campus? If so, could they cover a class for 20 minutes while a Mentor slips out to do an observation?
 - b. Is there a teacher specialist who could help out? For example, could a BTS Specialist without Rotations the first few weeks of school be used to help cover classes so that the Mentors can observe the Provisional Teachers? The Teacher Specialist can still teach his/her art form, but just to the classes involved with the observations.
- 2. If you have a Mentor and a Provisional Teacher that are on different grades, would it be possible to have the Mentor Teacher observe during his/her Rotation time?
- 3. Some schools provide a substitute teacher for IEP day where teachers leave their classrooms during the day for an IEP while a floating substitute moves from classroom to classroom. Could this same model be applied to Mentor Observations?
- 4. Does your school have Induction Coaching Money that could provide for substitutes for a more formal observation with the Lead Mentor, Provisional Teacher, and Mentor Teacher?
